If your child meets MCFD requirements for autism funding (see social worker for info), then you decide how you want to allocate your Autism Funding by creating a service plan that meets your family's needs. Pivot Point is 100% compliant with the Autism Funding Unit, Workers Compensation, Employment Standards Act, and Canada Revenue Agency. Once you select your services, one monthly invoice will be sent to the AFU for payment, keeping you in control and your paperwork short and simple!
